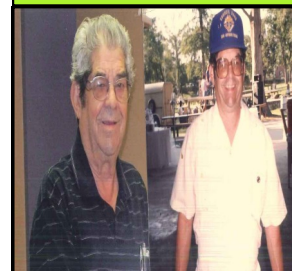

None of us likes to be under the scrutiny of another. We don't want Big Brother viewing our activities, and we don't care for those electronic cookies trailing us around the Internet. Privacy is an American ideal stacked up alongside liberty and individuality. Our business is our own.

Yet the restored Rites of Christian Initiation include rituals called Scrutinies, one of which is celebrated in many parishes today. Like the names suggests, Scrutinies are discerning looks at a person's motives, intended to uncover what's hidden. But they also aim to heal what may be weak and defective so the scrutinized are strengthened for the road ahead. Consider it a long, loving look, not a suspicious, disapproving stare. Who among us might not benefit from a loved one's searching gaze? Even when it comes with tough-love honesty about ways in which we need to change? Jesus looked at the Samaritan woman like that during their time together at the well. Because of his scrutiny, her life was forever stronger, more whole, more true.

Who gets to tell you the truth about yourself, even when it hurts?
