**I Do Believe**

In today's Gospel we read the wonderful story of the man born blind. It's one of the stories from John that are associated with the catechumen's Lenten journey to baptism and the community's growth in faith. This is a story of healing and faith, of physical blindness and spiritual blindness. Jesus is the light. If we accept the light then we will have life. The man is a model for the catechumens and for us as we make this Lenten journey. As we read the story, we see the man's faith grow. First he refers to Jesus as "the man called Jesus." Then he sees Jesus as a prophet, and he recognizes him as coming from God. Finally he proclaims, "I do believe, Lord." With him, we are called to profess our faith with confidence and joy.

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the Church's process of discerning and ritualizing the stages of gradual conversion in order for one to be baptized and received in to the community. The process moves from inquiry to catechesis to purification and enlightenment to further post-baptismal catechesis.
